Driver must be 14 years old by February 1st, 2026 to compete per NSS Rules and MUST have an up to date NASCAR License to compete.

Weights:

- GM Factory seal /10 in clutch 2575lbs
- Gm factory seal 7.25 clutch or Wall, Stafford, Thompson, MVS, Evergreen, Carolina crate with 10 in clutch 2600lbs
- Wall,Stafford, Evergreen,mvs Carolina crate with 7.25 clutch 2625 lbs
- Gm factory seal with 5.5 clutch 2650 lbs
- Wall ,Stafford, Mvs,evergreen, Carolina crate with 5.5 clutch 2675 lbs
- 56 percent left side
- Car weight car clutch size must be displayed on hood or DQ at scale.
- All Stafford, Thompson, Waterford cars
- * 55% left side
- *10" clutch
- *2bbl 4412 carb
- *2725lbs
- Car weight car clutch size must be displayed on hood or DQ at scale.

Transmissions Must Meet following requirements:

- Standard production transmission, which is available through dealers.
- NO TITANIUM OR CARBON FIBER PARTS ALLOWED.
- No ceramic type roller bearings
- No overdrive type transmissions allowed.
- A maximum of four (4) forward speeds
- Forward and Reverse gear must be in working order
- No automatic or semi-automatic transmissions
- No transmission will have a gear ratio between 1.00 and 1.15. The only high gear ratio permitted will be 1.00:1

Differential:

- Non quick change OK
- 4.11 minimum 4.12 maximum final drive ratio
- Lockers OK Gleason type OK

Tires and Wheels:

- Absolutely NO tire prep.
- Tires WILL be tested.
- No bleed valves
- 10" Hoosier F45 Star
 - ALL TIRES USED MUST BE PURCHASED AT NEW SMYRNA SPEEDWAY INCLUDING PRACTICE TIRES.
 - TIRES USED FOR QUALIFYING MUST BE USED FOR THAT NIGHT'S RACE.

Wheels: Steel wheels wide 5- MAXIMUM WIDTH 10 INCHES

- Radial Mount Brakes OK

Shocks: Non Adjustable NO Schrader valves - \$300 PER SHOCK limit

No Ride Height Rule

Fuel: Track fuel 5 gallons per day min

Exhaust: Carbon steel only no Merge collectors or tri Y

IMPORTANT NOTE: In the spirit of fair competition and this being a special event, all rules are subject to alterations and changes prior to and during the event.

A STRICT CODE OF CONDUCT MUST BE ADHERED TO AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE TRACK, EVENT ORGANIZERS, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT IF NECESSARY. BY ENTERING THIS EVENT YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE CODE OF CONDUCT.

Anyone breaking the General Code of Conduct will be immediately ejected from the event and a lifetime ban will be placed upon that driver and their crew members.
